Directions to the Hawk's Cay Resort in Duck Key, Florida

Directions:

By Land:

The southernmost stretch of Route US-1 is the main road leading in and out of the Florida Keys. Extending all the way from Miami to Key West, it is routinely called the Overseas Highway. Hawks Cay is at Mile Marker 61 of this trip, 61 miles north of Key West and approximately 90 miles south of Miami.

By Sea:

Because of their year-round boating weather, a great number of visitors to Hawks Cay choose to arrive by boat or yacht. Hawks Cay is located at waypoint: N24° 46.6' W80° 54.7'

By Air:

The resort is located just 9 miles from Marathon Airport – an ideal landing and take-off spot for small charter flights and private aircraft. Or, for guests that prefer commercial air travel, Key West International, Miami International, and Fort Lauderdale International all offer daily flights from numerous U.S. cities. Once you've landed, we're just a short drive away. ***See more information for these airports below.***

Gator Air (www.flygatorair.com) is a small local airline specializing in daily flights between Marathon Airport and Ft. Lauderdale International Airport. The twice-daily flights cost less than \$75 and serve as a perfect connection from larger commercial flights. Currently, Gator Air offers a morning flight that departs at 7:50 am and an afternoon flight that departs at 4:30 pm from Ft. Lauderdale International Airport. Key West International Airport

60 Miles from Hawk's Cay Resort

Driving Directions to Hotel From Key West International Airport:

Take U.S.-1 North to Mile Marker 61. Use right lane exit over bridge onto Duck Key. Continue until you see Hawk's Cay Resort entrance on the left. Proceed up the driveway to the resort.

Miami International Airport

100 Miles from Hawk's Cay Resort

Driving Directions to Hotel From Miami International Airport:

As you drive out of the Miami Airport, stay in the right lane of LeJeune Road. About a ½ mile down LeJeune, you should see the "836 West" exit. Take 836 West to the "Florida Turnpike South" exit. The Turnpike will turn into U.S. – 1 South. Take U.S. – 1 South until Mile Marker 61 – Duck Key. Make a left onto Duck Key and continue until you see Hawk's Cay Resort entrance on the left. Proceed up the driveway to the resort.

Fort Lauderdale Airport

125 Miles from Hawk's Cay Resort

Driving Directions to Hotel From Fort Lauderdale Airport:

As you drive out of the Ft. Lauderdale Airport, take Interstate-595 West to the Florida Turnpike and go South. The Turnpike will turn into U.S. – 1 South. Take U.S. – 1 South until Mile Marker 61 – Duck Key. Make a left onto Duck Key and continue until you see Hawk's Cay Resort entrance on the left. Proceed up the driveway to the resort.
